



We appreciate your interest in possibly hosting a craft show at your church. We are a stand and we do not schedule shows at fairs, or community events.

Check list for hosting a Craft Show

- Housing is needed for the Craft team.
 - Generally there are two or three people.
- Meals are needed for the team.
 - Friday night thru Sunday Morning.
- A Love Offering is needed to help with the travel expenses.
 - For example: The van expense alone to your church cost the craft program \$.92 (cents a mile.)
- We request that there are at least 5 to 6 people to help unload and set up when we arrive.
- We request that there are at least 5 to 6 people to help re-pack and load after the show is over.
- We would like time for at least a Mission Moment during Sunday services, school, preferably both.
- Our secondary job is to share the mission story of Red Bird.
- **We need to be a stand-alone event**, with the exception of food and bake sales.
 - History shows reduced sales when we are just part of an event.
- The Craft Sale is to be 5 hours long.
 - We recommend 9:00am till 2:00pm, as we have noticed that sales tend to drop off after 2:00pm
- Whenever possible we would like to have sales on Sunday.
 - The additional sales on Sunday's are at least 33% of the Saturday sales.
 - We need the additional sales to help create more economic opportunities for our crafters.
- We will need 20 to 25, 8-foot tables to display crafts on, as well as floor space to display furniture.
